**REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRATION AS A PHARMACIST IN PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND
CURRENTLY LICENSED IN ANOTHER MRA PROVINCE IN CANADA**

1. completed application form
2. verification from current licensing body that applicant is licensed and in good standing, i.e. “certification of standing”, indicating:
 - a. the period of time the applicant was licensed with that body
 - b. the current status of the applicant with that body
 - c. whether or not the applicant has been suspended or restricted with respect to the practice of pharmacy by that licensing body, and
 - d. confirmation that the applicant has complied with any continuing education or continuing competency requirements of that licensing body.
3. Provision of verification of a minimum of 450 hours of practice as a pharmacist in the previous 3 calendar years or 900hrs in 5 years.
4. successful completion, including payment of fees, of the jurisprudence examination administered by the PEIPB
5. payment of initial licensing fee and the annual licensing fee
6. forward “Pharmaceutical Information Program (PhIP) Registration form to the Provincial Government

Notes:

- (i) A legislation exam (jurisprudence) must be written unless the applicant has been an active member of the Prince Edward Island Pharmacy Board in the preceding two year period. Candidates must give notice to the Registrar of their intention to write the examination at least ten days prior to the date set for the examination.
